

Subject: FINDING OF CONFORMANCE WITH THE CIWMP FOR THE SUNSHINE
CANYON LANDFILLS, LOS ANGELES COUNTY AND CITY; FACILITY
NUMBERS 19-AA-0853 AND 19-AR-0002

The proposed permit is for the Sunshine Canyon Landfills (County and City sites), located at 14747 San Fernando Road, in Sylmar, Los Angeles County, 91342.

Public Resources Code Section 50001 requires the location of any new or expanded solid waste disposal facility to be identified in the applicable county's Countywide Siting Element (CSE) for the proposed permit for that facility to be found to be in conformance with the CSE.]

5 11 The location of the Sunshine Canyon landfill in the unincorporated area is identified in the County's CSE. The proposed expansion to merge the site in the unincorporated area and the site within the City limits is discussed and portrayed in a map in the County's CSE. The permitted boundary around both existing sites will not change with the proposed expansion. The Office of Local Assistance staff therefore finds the proposed permit to be in conformance with the County's CSE. "]
