Project Description: Step 1 PINs: 7084, 7036, 7068, 5956. This Proposal is comprised of 13 priority projects that will deliver a strong combination of water supply, water quality and other benefits. This set of high priority projects was developed through the Region's Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) planning process. When implemented, the Proposal will develop almost 18,000 AFY of new local water supplies, protect nearly 13,000 AFY existing supplies, promote water conservation, reduce dependence on imported water by approximately 9,000 AFY, create wetlands and parks that also capture and treat 6,000 AFY of stormwater runoff, and restore nearly 100 acres of riparian habitats in multiple locations.

In summary, five projects offer quantifiable water supply benefits, six projects offer quantifiable stormwater and urban runoff capture and treatment benefits (while all remaining projects offer other water quality benefits), and eight projects create wetlands, riparian, upland or steelhead habitat with significant open space and recreational opportunities. All of the priority projects are multi-objective in nature offering benefits in at least two of the benefits categories.
