

North Los Angeles/Kern County Regional Recycled Water Project Phase 2

This project constitutes Phase 2 of four phases of the North Los Angeles/Kern County Regional Recycled Water Project (RRWP). The overall scope of the RRWP includes the construction of a recycled water backbone distribution system to provide recycled water to the cities of Lancaster, Palmdale, and surrounding unincorporated communities in the Antelope Valley. The proposed facilities for this phase of the recycled water system include approximately 48,000 linear feet of pipeline, a 9,200-gallon-per-minute pump station, and a 3-million-gallon storage tank. The recycled water will be used for irrigation and other non-potable uses at commercial, industrial, and recreation facilities. This project is currently in the design phase and it is expected to start construction in 2014.
